\* That's just overtly sexist. Not cute.

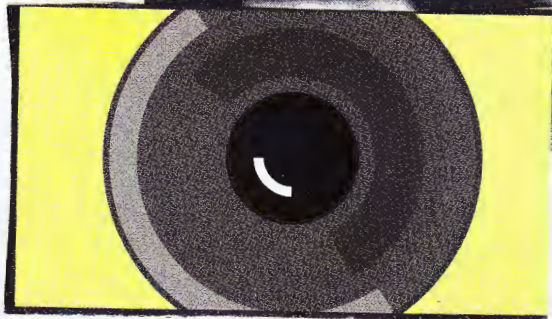

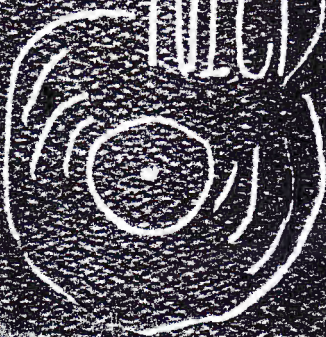

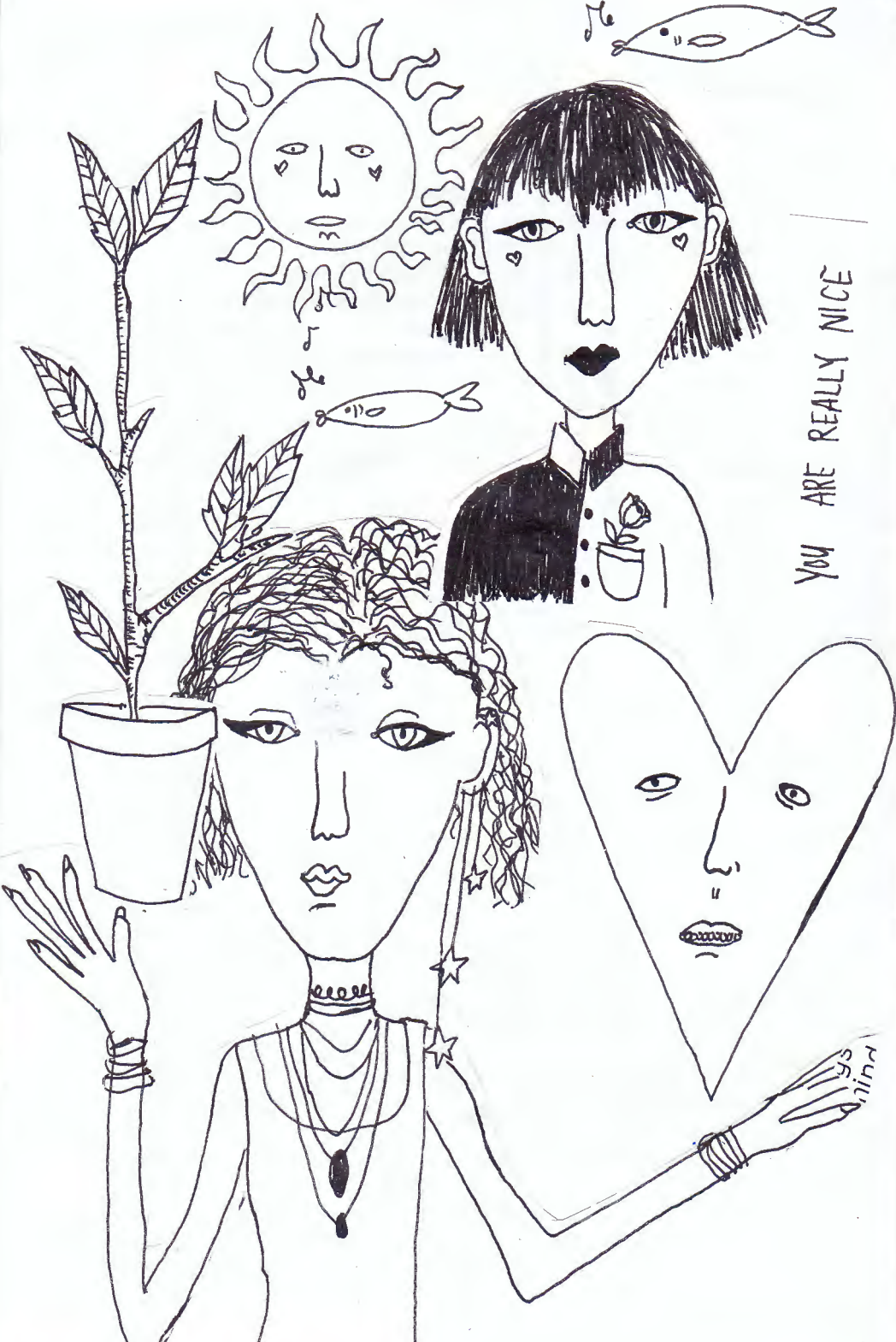
